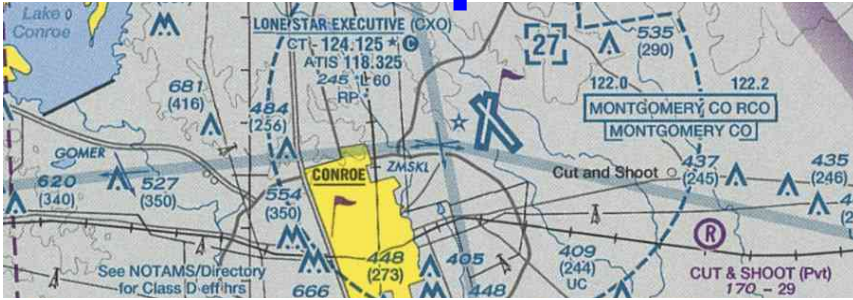

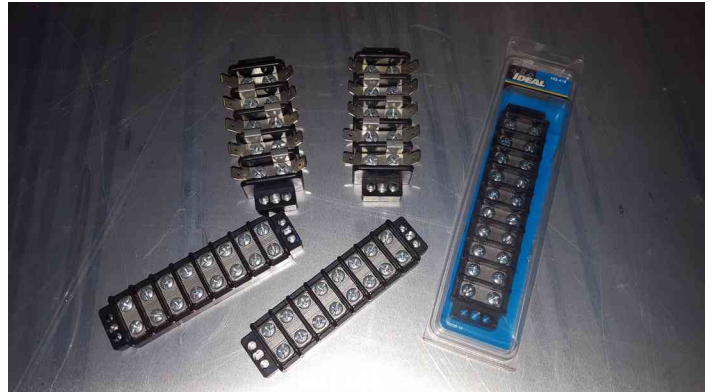

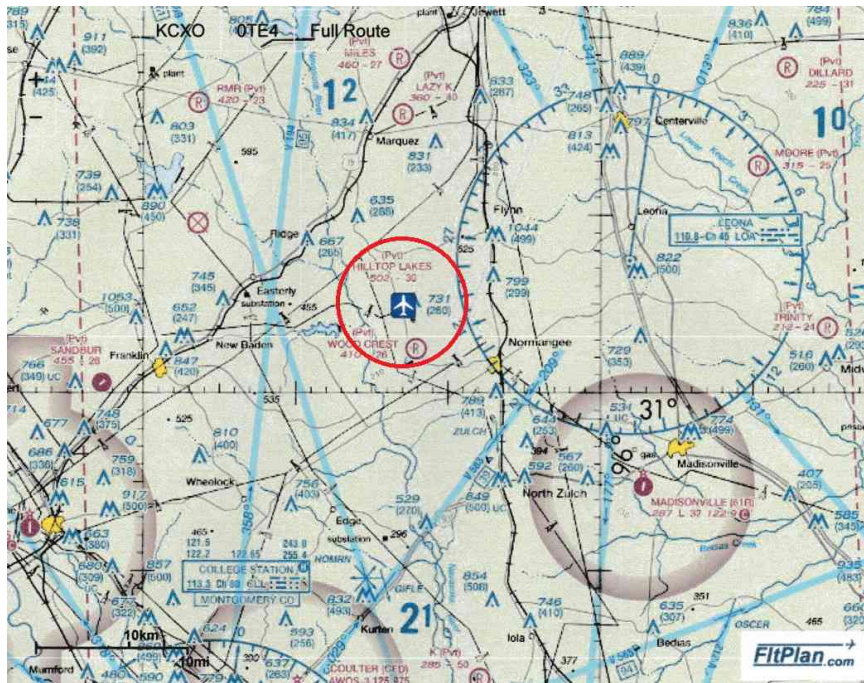

Bring your aircraft to the meeting to get a faster start. Hilltop Lakes is a live-in airport, golf and horse community just outside Normangee. Park your aircraft at the south end—west side. There are no taxiways, so watch out for back-taxiing aircraft. (Preferred runway is 17). It is about a 2 block walk from the parking to the clubhouse and restaurant. No buffet on Saturday until 5pm, but you can order from the menu. As usual, flyout is dependent on weather.
